



NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS:

THE FEDERAL EPA WILL REQUIRE CERTAIN RENOVATORS, REMOLDERS & PAINTERS TO BE EPA CERTIFIED BY APRIL 23, 2010

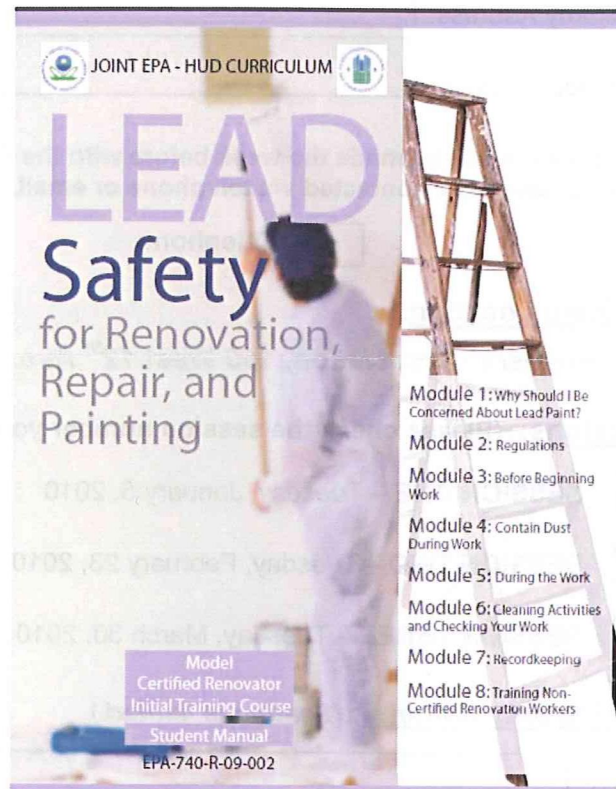
Beginning April 23, 2010, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will require firms performing work that disturbs lead-based paint in residential homes, child care facilities, and schools built before 1978 must:

- Be EPA certified,
- Ensure necessary EPA certified renovators are on each job,
- Ensure all workers affected are trained in specific work practices to prevent lead contamination,
- All work is performed according to EPA work practices,
- Pre-renovation education required for residents,
- Record Keeping requirements are met.

The EPA requires certified renovators must:

- Use a lead test kit to determine if lead is present,
- Provide on-the-job training in specific work practices for other workers onsite,
- Be physically present on the jobsite at times required by the EPA,
- Regularly direct the work of other employees to insure proper work practices,
- Be available either onsite or by telephone at all time renovation is being conducted,
- Have at the site a copy of certification certificate,
- Prepare required records.

Penalties for performing work without being EPA certified can be up to \$32,000 per violation, per day.
